MAKE-UP/HAIR

Just to confirm make up and hair is done by all of you (parents of the students), however if you are not confident then please do not hesitate to ask someone (there is always someone happy to help). The amount of make up applied is based on what you and your child feel happy with. For stage lights I definitely recommend foundation, blusher, lipstick and eye pencil.

LITTLE THEATRE REHEARSALS

Please remember that the teachers are on stage at all rehearsals and cannot be responsible for your children outside of their rehearsal time. Please ensure you either stay with your child or arrange for another adult to be responsible for them. We ask that they stay safe and seated in the theatre at all times and do not run around out of respect to the dancers on stage. If you/your child is concerned about any strangers in the theatre, please let me know. Students can take food and drink into the theatre but please take their rubbish with them.

FRIDAY – FULL DRESS REHEARSAL/SHOW

All students to arrive at 4pm and get ready – please note make up is not a requirement for this performance however if your child wishes then please do so at home.

This will be a tricky night with the students sitting in the audience but I feel strongly about letting them, so they don't miss out on the experience. Please bare with us, we will try to move it along as quickly and smoothly as we can. We will need some parent help so if you are willing please let me know. Thank you.

ALL PERFORMANCES

We do not allow parents side stage as space is limited however for those students under 5 years we will allow one parent.

In the changing rooms we require a couple of parents from each group to help watch the children and ensure they line up when called. Again the space is limited so not too many parents please – taking turns is a great idea and we really do appreciate your help. Please remember toilets are not to be used as changing rooms.

Please remember that students must not sit in the theatre during the ACT they are in. The doors will be closed for the duration of each ACT (except in the case of an emergency) and we will have a 20 minute intermission.
